This is a special invitation just for you. It's time again to remind you of Summerseat Farm's largest fund raiser, the 4th Annual Hand Made Quilt Auction. The date is Saturday, October 18 (rain or shine). Please come. The preview of auction items is 9:00 a.m. with the auction starting promptly at 10:00 a.m. The auctioneer is the ever colorful, Rodney Thompson. We have a large, room sized, windowed tent. There's no admission or parking fee. Handicapped parking is available. Rest room facilities are nearby. In addition to the assortment of Twin, Queen, King sized quilts of varying intricate designs and colors, there will be wall hangings; pillows; hand made lawn furniture; planters; dinner for 4 at Summerseat; pictures and other surprises. The quilts and furniture, vegetables and plants, are made & grown by our local Mennonite community. There will be food and drinks available for sale, including buffalo burgers. Cash, checks, VISA, MasterCard & Discover are accepted and a 10% buyers premium is charged. To get to Summerseat, take Rt. 5 South to Rt. 235 (at WAWA). Continue on Rt. 235 for another 4 miles, and Summerseat is on the right. Or, from La Plata, take Rt. 6 East, turn right (South) on Rt. 5 and continue

to the RT 235/Rt 5 split at WAWA, then 4 more miles. This is an exciting and fun auction with plenty of action! Rodney is a well known auctioneer who is quite entertaining...never a dull moment. Direct questions to 301-373-6607 or 301-481-9189.

At the farm, you'll see our herd of buffalo (American bison) on one side of the driveway and our herd of Barbados sheep (hair sheep--no shearing--they shed) on the other. You might see a few ducks, geese, turkeys, guinea keets, and chickens wandering freely. You can also visit our assortment of goats; Jimmy, the pig; JR, the donkey; Annabelle, a miniature Hereford cow. This is a beautiful and serene 18th century farm and house with lovely gardens and goldfish pond, a gazebo looking down over the barns, animals and auction site; with a small family cemetery where former residents rest peacefully. Come out and enjoy a full day at Summerseat. Have your bidding hand strong and ready to wave!
