As some of you may have noticed in last month's newsletter, the calendar erroneously listed April 6th as the 45th Anniversary of the Greater Waldorf Jaycees. The chapter was in May of 1969, thus our 40th Anniversary will be next year.

- **Attention Golfers/Shoppers/Sand Lovers**

Dates: Sun., Oct 12 – Mon., Oct 13 – Tues., Oct 14 / 2008

Where: Holiday Inn – 17th & Boardwalk, Ocean City, MD

Cost: Golfers \$300 per golfer - Non-Golfers \$100 per person

A \$25 non-refundable deposit to be received no later than July 1, 2008. 21 rooms are already booked and there are very few left. Remember this is a first come first serve basis as of now. All rooms are Oceanfront. Smoking rooms are limited and are located on the 2nd floor up. 1st floor is totally non-smoking.

Currently the \$99 room rate I received was quoted for Sunday and Monday evenings only (which is when the actual trip is scheduled for). However, several people have expressed the desire to go up on Fri or Sat. Unfortunately, Fri. and Sat. quotes are at \$149.

To make it equal for all persons each room occupied will be allocated an allowance of \$200; therefore, any charges incurred above the \$200 those individuals occupying that room will be liable. So a room booked for Fri/Sat/Sun would cost approx \$350 (99/99/149). The individuals staying in that room would have paid \$100 ea (the cost per non golfer); therefore, those individuals would owe an extra \$150.

An example:

Stacey Crowe 1 Room for Fri/Sat/Sun/Mon (149/149/99/99) would total \$500: Cost \$500 – allowable \$200 = \$300 extra (above the \$200 paid for trip) due by Stacey Crowe (I end up paying the rate for the 2 extra nights).

Another example:

Craig Galope 1 Room booked for Sat/Sun (149/99) would total \$250: Cost \$250 – allowable \$200 = \$50 extra (above the \$200 paid for trip) due by Craig Galope (He ends up paying a portion of the rate for Saturday).

The dinners are currently set at Harpoon Hannahs for Sunday and Monday night. I am sorry but there can not be any allowances for other nights (ex. If you are only staying Fri/Sat then unfortunately you would miss dinner)

If anyone has any questions they can contact me at the Jaycee Center.
